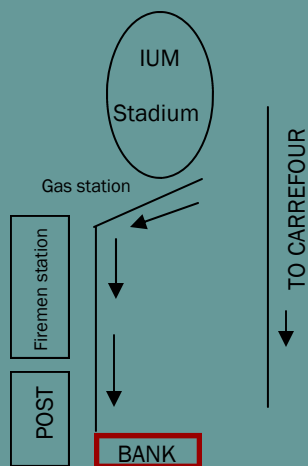


HOW CAN I OPEN A BANK ACCOUNT?

- Gather all the documents you need (passport, Letter of introduction)
- Get an appointment (with the help of the IUM reception)

HOW CAN I CLOSE A BANK ACCOUNT?

- Make an appointment with the bank 1 month before your departure (1st week of June)
- Proceed to a pre-closing, get your deposit back and sign all official documents.



Opening a French Bank Account remains essential for students who are willing to get a permit of stay 'carte de séjour', to open phone lines, internet access, cell phone subscription and many other contracts which require to have a French bank identification number and French cheques.

To open a bank account, YOU WILL NEED:

- Your passport copy
- Letter of introduction (provided upon request by Carine Voisin)

With this bank account, YOU WILL HAVE:

- A checking and Savings account (Compulsory to open the two)
- VISA Credit Card Classic
- French Checkbook, Bank Identification Number
- Possibility to check via internet your account (free access)

IT WILL COST YOU:

Checking account: 5.55€/month (under 25)-7€80/month (over 25)

Savings account: (Guarantee for the bank that will be given back to you at your account's closing)

IUM Undergraduate & Graduate students: 500€ deposit minimum during the time you are client at the bank
